



Card Trick

Here is an old block that would work well in a block swap. You could also make each of the four 'cards' a different color, for a great scrap quilt!

For a single Card Trick block in three colors, you would need:

Dark

2—4 $\frac{7}{8}$ inch squares, cut once on the diagonal

1—5 $\frac{1}{4}$ inch square, cut twice on the diagonal

Medium

2—4 $\frac{7}{8}$ inch squares, cut once on the diagonal

1—5 $\frac{1}{4}$ inch square, cut twice on the diagonal

Light

2—4 $\frac{7}{8}$ inch squares, cut once on the diagonal

1—5 $\frac{1}{4}$ inch square, cut twice on the diagonal

Arrange as pictured in the block. Consider using Magic Sizing to prevent the bias edges from stretching. This will make piecing much easier.
